RE: Construction of Bulk Storage Warehouses in 2020

Chairman Clay,

We appreciate the opportunity to again apply for assistance from the Albany County Industrial Development Agency (IDA). We are writing this cover letter to provide some additional background on the project and dynamics surrounding the continued operation and growth that is being proposed.

As background, the tenants of the Port of Coeymans and Coeymans Industrial Park, both wholly owned subsidiaries of the Carver Companies over the past decade have imported road salt into our Port facility.

The operation historically has consisted of our tenants importing ship loads of 35,000 to 50,000 tons at a time from which Carver Companies would offload from the vessel and haul to an asphalt pad at our port or industrial park. We would stockpile the material and cover it with industrial tarps. When the winter season would come, we would remove sections of the tarp, load out the salt into over the road trucks, including our own and other trucking companies, bound for their respective destinations. Our tenant's customers range from state and local governmental entities, to commercial and industrial users of the salt.

In recent years, our tenants have continued to grow their businesses within our locations while facing increasing scrutiny from both their customers, and environmental regulation agencies. The scrutiny from their customers relates to moisture content from the salt stored outdoors, under tarps, and the scrutiny from the regulatory agencies also surrounds salt being stored outdoors, under tarps.

As such, we have repurposed existing buildings and built two new smaller buildings at our facilities for the purpose of storing the salt indoors, however on a limited scale. Currently for 2020 we are looking at constructing two new warehouses, measuring 180,000 and 250,000 square feet respectively that would be capable of storing all of our tenants salt stockpiles indoors, with room for their planned growth.

We believe this is a bit of a unique application, as the employees required to operate the warehouse, loadout, and scaling operations when the tenant is actively selling the product is just a minor fraction of the total employees required for the process, from getting the salt from the vessel to the eventual end user.

Our enclosed application outlines our current 8 FTE employees used for this operation, proposing growth upon completion to 18 FTE. These are the employees listed above that are engaged in the warehousing, loadout, and scaling operations.

Putting estimated numbers to the ancillary activities; we currently utilize approximately 12 FTE for the salt stevedoring activities (from the ship to the pile), which would grow to approximately 25 FTE at the tenants proposed volume.

Regarding the FTE involved in delivering the product, this is more difficult to estimate as the customer base ranges from New York City, north to Plattsburgh, west to Utica, and east to Central Massachusetts and Carver Companies only delivers approximately one third of the product. With that being said, we estimate there are currently 50 FTE from many trucking companies involved in this delivery process from October through March, which could grow to over 100 FTE as the business and footprint continue to expand.

As you can see, the ancillary FTE, both at the current level and future proposed levels account for over 80% of the FTE jobs relating to this overall supply chain, so we felt it was important to detail the whole supply chain in this letter to the IDA.

Again, we appreciate the opportunity to apply for the assistance of the IDA, and look forward to working through this process with you.


