ALBANY COUNTY INDUSTRIAL DEVELOPMENT AGENCY

This is to certify that the Albany County Industrial Development Agency has been established by special act of the New York State Legislature, and the following is set forth pursuant to Section 856 of the New York State Industrial Development Agency Act:

(1) The special act establishing the Agency passed June 9, 1975, by Chapter 178 of the Laws of 1975 which became effective June 9, 1975.

(2) The name of the Agency is: Albany County Industrial Development Agency.
